We have a growing, generationally diverse membership. We offer numerous structured programs for study, fellowship, service, and worship for all ages throughout the week, including *Wednesdays at First*, our long-standing mid-week fellowship dinner and study opportunity.

We are a caring church revealed through the love we have for others. We use the gifts given to us to further God's kingdom and serve our neighbors. We serve those in need in our community by caring for families living in local motels, housing homeless families through IHN, feeding the hungry through a weekly meal ministry, and distributing over 1000 new coats annually to children in need throughout Spartanburg County. Our facility houses Mobile Meals and the Shepherd's Center, two organizations serving seniors throughout our community. We serve our denomination with generous contributions to Presbyterian causes and serve the world with annual congregational and youth mission trips that have included the Dominican Republic, Cuba and Haiti. We support missionaries in the Dominican Republic, Haiti, Lesotho, and the Middle East. Our Weekday School helps over 100 preschoolers to grow in God's grace, and our dynamic music program enables invites people from 6 weeks-old through adults to sing God's praises.
