

PUBLICITY FOR 2018 S.T.E.P.S.

Here are some sample articles you can use to publicize the S.T.E.P.S. event. The STEPS Planning Team wishes to thank you in advance for helping get the word out about this Charleston Atlantic Presbytery event.

Option One:

S.T.E.P.S.- Studying + Teaching + Equipping + Praying + Serving: This presbytery-wide event is a wonderful opportunity for high school youth and adult church members, teachers, ministry teams, worship/music leaders, officers and staffs to enrich their faith and understanding of the church. S.T.E.P.S. will take place Saturday, August 25th at the Mount Pleasant Presbyterian Church. Check-in begins at 8:15 and the day will conclude at 4:15 with a closing *Iona* worship service. Participants have an opportunity to worship, take three workshops, and fellowship with others in our presbytery; as well as visit displays from various institutions and organizations and shop at the bookstore. Pre-registration deadline is August 10th and the registration fee is \$35. Register by July 15th and you can take advantage of the early bird registration fee of \$25. No pre-registrations will be taken after August 10th. We encourage you to pre-register, but if your plans change and you can attend at the last minute, you may register at the event (\$40). Registration information is on the presbytery website (www.capresbytery.org/steps) and printed brochures have been mailed to your church. We hope to see you at S.T.E.P.S. 2018 exploring the church in a changing world.

Option Two:

Studying, Teaching, Equipping, Praying, Serving... These words make up the acronym STEPS and I am here to share a little bit about the Charleston Atlantic Presbytery's annual STEPS event. This year's theme is *The Church in a Changing World* based on Hebrews 13:8 which says, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today, and forever." and Isaiah 49:6b, "...I will give you as a light to the nations, that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth." On Saturday, August 25th YOU have the opportunity to hear Leanne Van Dyk, president of Columbia Theological Seminary preach; as well as study alongside seminary professors/presidents; discover ways to be the church in a changing world; explore ways to carve out time with God; and explore how our faith impacts our daily lives. You will have the opportunity to participate in a wide variety of workshops like... Oh, there are just too many to name in a "Moment for Mission." If I named just a few, I would leave out the ONE that would grab your attention. Take my word for it- there is something for high school youth through adults.
