What are the opportunities for service?

Below is a brief description of the ministry teams, commissions, committees, boards, and agencies. For more detailed information, go to the *Committee on Representation* page on the presbytery website: www.capresbytery.org.

ACCOUNTABILITY

Shepherding Team serves as the catalyst for God's work in the world by overseeing the connectional life of the presbytery; reviewing the work of the ministry teams, committees, commissions, boards, and agencies; and visioning of the presbytery's life and ministry.

Stewardship of Financial Resources Ministry Team plans, monitors, presents, and executes the budget and is responsible for stewardship education.

Committee on Representation solicits, identifies, and recommends individuals with the gifts, skills, and passion for the various ministries and agencies of the presbytery.

Permanent Judicial Commission serves as an advisory committee on interpretation of the PCUSA Constitution and adjudicates disciplinary cases.

NURTURE

Commission on Ministry cares for our teaching elder members; provides professional development opportunities for teaching elders, commissioned ruling elders, Christian educators, and church musicians; reviews session minutes and registers; and assists congregations with vacant pulpits.

Preparation for Ministry Team oversees the inquirer and candidacy stages of preparation for calls to ministry as a teaching elder; accepts and prepares those training as Commissioned Ruling Elders; and provides guidance for those preparing for a call to educational ministry.

Nurture Ministry Team provides the presbytery opportunities for leadership development, spiritual and faith formation for all ages, and maintaining a print and media resource center.

SERVICE

Service to Others Ministry Team includes such ministries as mission, evangelism, justice issues, Hispanic Ministry, Self-Development of People, and Presbyterian Disaster Assistance.
